Calendar:

- Postmark/ Email deadline: April 10, 2010
- Notifications sent via Email: May 10, 2010
- Delivery of accepted work: May 18-29, 2010 (during museum hours or by appointment)
- Exhibition on view: July 10 - September 4, 2010
- Opening reception: July 10, 2010 4-6 pm, Awards Ceremony 4 pm
- Art work pick-up: September 8-18, 2010 (during museum hours or by appointment)

Eligibility:

- The Wabash Valley Juried Exhibition is open to all artists, working in any media, residing in Indiana or within a 150 mile radius of Terre Haute, Indiana. All work must be safe to handle, install and view.
- 2-D work must be no larger than 6 feet in any direction and cannot exceed 50 lbs.
- 3-D individual components of 3-D work cannot exceed 6x3x2 feet. 3-D work cannot exceed 100 lbs.
- Accepted work with unusual display requirements, including electronic media and 3-D work, must come equipped with appropriate display hardware. Due to the Swope's unique interior, works cannot be taped or nailed directly to the wall, nor hung from the ceiling.
- Submitted work must be original artwork completed within the last three years, and not previously exhibited at the Swope. (No work completed before 2007.)

Juror:

- This year's distinguished juror is Dr. Gregory Gilbert, associate professor and director of the Art History Program at Knox College in Galesburg, Illinois and senior curator of the Figge Art Museum in Davenport, Iowa where he is director of the National Center for Midwest Art and Design.

Awards:

- Over \$5,000 in purchase awards and merit prizes are awarded annually once selected work has been delivered.
- Purchase awards become the property of the sponsor/buyer at the close of the exhibition. Works marked NFS are not eligible for purchase awards but are eligible for merit awards selected by the juror. A people's choice award will be presented at the close of the exhibition.

Entry Fee:

- There is a \$30 non-refundable entry fee (\$25 for Swope members) to submit three works of art. The Swope accepts personal checks, money orders, Visa and MasterCard. Please make checks payable to: Swope Art Museum.

Entry Procedures:

- Each artist may submit images of up to three works of art. (Two views per sculptural work.)
- Submissions may be made digitally via email or a CD sent through the post. See submission specifications below.

Images:

- Images must be no larger than 5x7 inches at 300dpi
- Image Files should be saved as JPEGs with the following name: Artist's last name_entry letter.jpg

Reproduction:

- By submitting images you grant the Swope permission to use images on the Swope website or in Swope publications.

Email Submissions:

- Send submissions to WVE@Swope.org
- The subject of your email should read: "2010 WVE submission"
- Include in your email: Artist's name, address, email, phone, payment info* and payment amount.
- Submission letter, Artist's name, Title, Date of completion, medium, dimensions, value and if the art work is for sale.

CD Submissions:

- Submit one disk containing all images (JPEG) and label the disk with the artist's name, address, email and phone.
- Include in your mail submission:
 - CD with images
 - Completed entry form with method of payment and payment amount
 - Entry fee

CDs will not be returned.

Delivery of accepted works:

- Accepted work may be hand delivered or sent via UPS, USPS or FedEx to:
Swope Art Museum, Attn: 2010 WVE, 25 South 7th St., Terre Haute, IN 47807
- Accepted work must arrive ready to exhibit and in re-useable packing materials. (No Packing Peanuts!)
- Label accepted work with: name, title, date, medium, value, if the work is for sale and mark the top.
- All wall hanging work must arrive with adjustable hanging hardware.
- Frames with glazing should use acrylic glazing or plexi, no glass unless delivered and picked up by hand.
- Stretched canvases do not need frames, but should be presentable (no frayed edges).
- All work delivered in pieces must include written assembly instructions.
- Any accepted/delivered works that differ in quality or are not representative of the digital image file may be disqualified. The judge's decision is final.
- Electronic media must come with its own player/hardware and clear easy instructions. Self repeating programs are required.

Insurance and Sales:

- The Swope Art Museum will insure all exhibited works for the duration of the exhibition at their estimated sale price. Sales are encouraged, but not required. The Museum will take a 30% commission on sales (or 10% commission from purchase awards).

Pick-up / Return of exhibited work:

- Accepted work cannot be withdrawn before the close of the exhibition.
- Work must be picked up between September 8-18, 2010 during museum hours, or by appointment.
- If shipped, the Museum will repack the work but the artist is responsible for payment of return shipping, and the work must arrive in re-useable packing materials. Works not claimed by September 18, 2010 become the property of the Swope Art Museum and will be disposed of at the discretion of the Museum.

The Danette Angermeier Memorial Fund was established in 1999 after the untimely death of Terre Haute photographer Danette Angermeier (1960-1999). The fund was set up to provide an ongoing source to fund a memorial merit award in Danette's name. Your contributions go toward the fund's principle and the merit award is drawn from the interest the fund accumulates. This award is given at the annual *Wabash Valley Juried Exhibition* to distinguish a deserving artwork in any medium. Danette was a graduate of the Indiana State University MFA program and a local artist working in photography. Danette exhibited widely, won numerous awards at the Swope's annual *Wabash Valley Juried Exhibition*, and is represented in the Swope collection.
